

# Financial impact of health and safety offences increasing

Since the introduction of new sentencing guidelines in 2015/16 for breaches of the Health and Safety at Work Act and its delegated legislation average fines imposed by UK courts have quadrupled and multi million pound penalties on large organisations are becoming commonplace<sup>182</sup>.
